We will also be celebrating the winners of the Tim Fleming Memorial Scholarship (we have 2 this year) and also hear from ACEC CA President Miranda Patton to be updated on what's happening in ACEC at the state level.

In December, I announced the new ACEC Sierra Chapter - Caltrans District 3 Professional Liaison Committee (D3 PLC) that was freshly chartered. This committee consists of four representatives from ACEC Sierra Chapter firms, four representatives from Caltrans District 3 staff and four representatives from other local agencies. As previously described, this committee will provide input to Caltrans Headquarters' PLC relating to the programs and operations germane to Caltrans District 3. The mission of the D3 PLC will be to share information that drives decisions, foster collaborative working relationships, discuss and act upon areas of shared interests such as funding sources, technical issues, and policy issues.
